COURSE OBJECTIVES:

These courses are designed for teachers of English at Secondary level (ages 11 – 18) and in adult education.

They are highly practical courses providing new skills and ideas for using digital technologies to teach English and for motivating learners through activities based on computers and mobile devices.

Participants work with websites, tools and digital technology so that they will be able to use them confidently in class. They will come away with a range of materials adapted and produced on the course.

COURSE CONTENT:

1. Workshops: Using Technology for Teaching English (4, 5 or 6 days) with expert TEFL trainers such as Graham Workman and Lucy Norris

A variety of approaches and ideas for using technology to teach English will be introduced including:

- examining effective classroom pedagogies for technology
- ICT language needed to work with a range of technologies for lesson preparation
- guidance and practice using computers and other devices to design lesson materials
- the production of lesson materials for your learners
- recommended web-based resources for teaching English
- the creation of open web-based learning areas for all your classes
- how and why to make and use wikis and podcasts
- exploiting and creating videos for learning
- practice using your computer to mark written work and provide feedback
- using web 2.0 tools creatively for in and out of class projects & homework
- ideas for motivating learners through activities which use technology to engage their imaginations and creativity
- using smartphones and Apps for learning English inside and outside the classroom

The course will involve working with online materials in order to adapt them for lessons with your learners, and you will need to bring a laptop for use when accessing and working on materials in the practical workshop sessions.

You should also bring a tablet (eg ipad) and/or smartphone if you can.
